## Mark your Measurements

Start by using a Pencil or painter's tape to mark measurements from the corner out to these measurements on each of the two walls you're using.

These measurements are the maximum space you need to create every layout option available in the specified Bridge size, in both the design picture and in a mirrored fashion. Measuring this expanded space allows you to pick the best layout depending on the location of your wall studs.

If you don't have this amount of space available, look at the following diagrams for your bridge length and choose a layout to fit your wall space.

34" Bridge - $75^{\prime \prime}$
50" Bridge - $82^{\prime \prime}$
66" Bridge - 98 "

Since we're showing installation for a 34" Bridge, we've measured out 75" from each corner. Next, locate and mark wall studs between the marked space and the corner of the wall.

Our 34" Slotted Shelves connect to the Mounting Planks either at the holes in the ends of the Shelves or through the slots in the sides.

Look at the layouts for your Bridge length and compare layout options by holding up a 34" Slotted Shelf to your walls to see where the studs will line up with potential mounting points. Try to find a layout that will allow you to install a Mounting Plank into a stud within 10 " of where the Bridge will attach to the Shelf, to prevent the Bridge from being bouncy.

Mounting Plank

* If you're new to installing our furniture, consider Layout A. Since the bridge is attached to the side of the Shelf instead of the end, it allows you to mount the Shelves in a wide range of placements on the wall.

Once you pick your layout from the diagram, use a Pencil or painter's tape to mark the measurements shown, then mark 34" towards the corner from each measurement to mark the Shelf location.

Since we're showing instructions for $34-\mathrm{B}$, we've chosen 4 studs that will work best for that layout.

Install two Top Mounting Screws in the Plank bracket. Use the Electric Drill to pre-drill a hole through the opening on the underside of the Plank. Install a Bottom Mounting Screw. Follow the angle of the opening for the proper hold in the stud.


Align the first Mounting Plank on the stud. Use an Electric Drill to pre-drill two top bracket holes using the $1 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$ Drill Bit. Keep in mind that the second Plank can be placed at either the end of the Shelf or anywhere along the slots. The most secure fit will be to find a second stud in that location.


Use the 34 " Shelf to measure the distance to the next Mounting Plank location. Hold the Shelf Top in place against the wall on a Plank. Use the Level to make sure the Shelf lays flat on the Plank. Install the Bottom Mounting Screw.


Remove the 34" Slotted Shelf and install two Top Mounting Screws through the mounting bracket holes.


Align an Angled Platform with the end of the $34^{\prime \prime}$ Slotted Shelf. It's best if you're able to attach one of the Long Furniture Bolts to a Mounting Plank; if they do not align with stud placement, then be sure to have the Plank installed close to the Platform to prevent the Bridge from being bouncy. Install two Long Furniture Bolts with Cap Nuts to fasten the Platform to the Shelf. (If you're mounting one of the Bolts to a Plank, you won't need the Cap Nut for that Bolt.)


To begin with the second 34" Slotted Shelf, find the location of the farthest Mounting Plank. Install two Top Mounting Screws in the plank bracket. Install a Bottom Mounting Screw on the underside of the Plank. Follow the angle of the opening for the proper hold in the stud.


Use the 34" Slotted Shelf to measure the distance to the final Mounting Plank location. Hold the Shelf Top in place against the wall on the Mounting Plank. Use the Level to make sure the Shelf lays flat on the Plank. Install the Bottom Mounting Screw.


Place the 34" Slotted Shelf on the Mounting Plank. Fasten the Shelf Top to the Planks using four Furniture Bolts


Install two Top Mounting Screws in the Plank Bracket.

Align the Angled Platform with the short end of the Shelf along the openings for the Mounting Plank. Fasten the Angled Platform to the Shelf with two Furniture Bolts and Cap Nuts.


Place the Bridge Top on the Angled Platform and fasten it in place with two Long Furniture Bolts and Cap Nuts. Repeat this process for the second Bridge mounting point.


## Acclimation Tips

Now that your cat's new furniture is installed, you want to give your cat positive reinforcements so they will relate the area to good things. We highly suggest incorporating things like catnip, playtime, or giving them treats from their new furniture.Any time we get treats out, our cat Heisenberg jumps onto a wall complex because that's where we always feed him treats.


If a cat is hesitant about walking on the bridge, try placing a towel, pad or blacket on the railings to make the surface more steady feeling as they warm up to the spot.

We recommend offering your cat a safe route off the furniture from both sides. Having multiple exit routes is important for their safety, especially in homes with multiple cats. This is a structure that will potentially be high on the wall. We offer plenty of solutions which can be found on our website. You could include a Scratching Pole or series of platforms for your cat to climb to the Corner Bridge.
